

# Concealed Handgun Course Safety and Policies

## Firearms Safety

1. Never point the muzzle of a firearm at anyone or yourself.
2. Double check that you bring no live ammunition into the classroom.
3. Load firearms on specific direction from the training staff at the range only.
4. Keep your finger off the trigger unless given permission by the training staff.
5. Never handle a firearm you do not know how to use.
6. Do not handle another person's firearms without permission.
7. When not using firearms keep them safely cased or action visibly opened upward.

## General Policies

1. Train slowly there is no rush or time limits. Especially go slowly when drawing and holstering from a concealed location.
2. Do not do anything that would endanger yourself or others
3. You must fully disclose any medical problems privately to the instructor.
4. Think ahead and stay organized.
5. Have a higher than normal level of awareness in class. Keep 360-degree awareness.
6. Take good notes and refer to your booklet.
7. Write down your questions to help clarify them before asking.
